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An assumption is an unstated opinion that is part of the argument. Nearly all arguments contain assumptions. Part of the process of critical reading must is uncovering assumption. A belief (religious, moral, cultural, ethical) is not an argument. Neither are personal likes or dislikes. These cannot be argued and should not be considered part of argument.
